Our Family Counsellor provides therapy to families and family members referred by the Ministry of Child and Family Development and the community. Therapist will assess, formulate, and carry out case plans for effective intervention with families dealing with a child or youth with mental health challenges or with families referred by the child protection system. Working with a trauma informed perspective, interventions will range from brief to longer term. This position requires a strong team player who can effectively liaise with social workers, clinicians, and community professionals.

Hours: 28-35 hours/week, flexibility required.
