# **Key Responsibilities**

### Railway Duties (Train runs 3 days/week):

- Assist with train operations and passenger service
- Greet and interact with passengers, providing local history and railway facts
- Read from the historical tour script over the PA system during rides
- Assist passengers with boarding and detraining (including children, pets, and individuals with disabilities)
- Support ticket sales at the station and help organize events

#### **Museum/Grounds Maintenance:**

- Perform basic landscape maintenance (weed-eating, lawn mowing, trimming blackberry bushes)
- Clean and maintain railway coaches: sweep floors, wipe down seats, polish/wax exterior
- Decorate coaches for events and conduct minor painting/clean-up tasks
- Take out garbage and ensure cleanliness and presentation of passenger coaches and public areas
- Assist in minor maintenance of historic rail equipment

The Alberni Pacific Railway is operated by the Western Vancouver Island Industrial Heritage Society. Operated on the unceded traditional territory of the Tseshaht and Hupacasath First Nations.

- Able to work independently and as part of a team
- Physically capable of walking throughout the site, lifting up to 50 lbs, and moving safely through a train coach in motion

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period
- Able to work flexible hours, including weekends and holidays
