- 2. Assists with assessing and evaluating existing bereavement programs and education
- 3. Assists in the development of new education and support programs
- 4. Acts as a liaison with other community agencies and services promoting hospice services
- 5. Maintains records and statistical data of all child and youth grief and bereavement clients.
- 6. Provides written reports as required to the Executive Director and for the Annual General Meeting
- 7. Attends related meetings
- 8. Maintains an active commitment to professional development.
- 9. Creating groups for children and youth
- 10. Training and supporting volunteer facilitators

- 2. Recognized hospice training course upon acceptance of employment
