

## Ha-Shilth-Sa Reporter (Term)

Ha-Shilth-Sa Newspaper is seeking a term, full-time General Assignment reporter with special interest in national/provincial/Nuu-chah-nulth relations and sports reporting. Requires a strong work ethic, and experience in photography and video-storytelling. Based out of Port Alberni, the reporter will work under the direction of the Ha-Shilth-Sa Editor and adhere to the values of lisaak and Hishukish Tsawalk, and those guidelines set out by the publisher, the Nuu-chah-nulth Tribal Council. This is a term position to March 31, 2021 (with the possibility of a permanent extension).

## **Duties will include:**

- Report on and photograph events, including sports and cultural activities, involving Nuu-chahnulth First Nations
- Prepare news stories of interest to Nuu-chah-nulth people with content and perspective from the Nuu-chah-nulth worldview, and meet established deadlines, including daily web requirements
- Travel throughout Nuu-chah-nulth communities and beyond; long hours, including weekends, are required
- Some layout required

## **Preferred Qualifications:**

- A degree in journalism, or equivalent experience
- Experience in a news gathering and producing environment
- ◆ Computer literate, including knowledge of windows-based programs, InDesign, Photoshop
- Ability to move with urgency to cover a story when required
- Must have access to a reliable vehicle and valid driver's license
- Provide acceptable references and criminal record check
