



Specialized Youth Worker-Outreach and Group

Program: ISE Program/CREW Program

Position: Youth Worker

Hours: 24 hours per week; Some evening and weekend work *may* be required

This role is eligible for extended health and other benefits

ADAPS Youth and Family seeks a committed, experienced youth worker to complement their service delivery team. The role will work with the Intensive Support and Engagement Team (ISE), which delivers a broad range of support services to youth. This role also co-facilitates the CREW group program, which is ADAPS' Early Prevention social group. The position requires recent experience working with **school-aged** populations ages 10-13. Experience working with youth in and from care and familiarity with the MCFD ICM care planning model is an asset.

This role works in the community and out of our Youth Service Office.

ISE - 18 hours per week

The Specialized Youth worker will provide ISE support to younger youth via outreach, developing pro-social and pro-recreational skills and experiences. Support to families, caregivers, and siblings is occasionally within the scope of the role. Preference will be given to candidates with HSW/ECE/CYCC or other relevant education and at least two years of experience working with diverse youth and family populations.

CREW Co Facilitation-6 hours per week

The successful candidate will have group facilitation experience, a positive and energetic attitude, and an uncanny ability to build rapport with school-aged children and youth. CREW is a focused early intervention group that builds wellness and protective factors with younger youth who may need social support. Knowledge of the Circle of Courage Framework is considered an asset.

A Criminal Records review and a valid driver's license with a clean abstract are also required.
