

## Relief Innkeeper

**Location:** InnChanter – Ucluelet, British Columbia (Floating Bed & Breakfast)

**Position Type:** Short-term, Seasonal

**Compensation:** \$450/day rate | \$250 half day | \$150 on-call day

**Shift Duration:** 2–4 consecutive days per shift.

**Season :** Late May/Early June through to Early October

### About the InnChanter

The InnChanter is a unique floating bed and breakfast anchored in the harbour in Ucluelet, BC. Hosting private groups of 8–12 guests, we provide an immersive, off-grid West Coast experience with boat access only, gourmet shared meals, kayaking, sauna sessions, and warm hospitality.

Just five minutes by boat from town, the InnChanter feels entirely removed from it all, with bald eagles perched, seals and sea lions moving through the harbour, and black bears sometimes feeding along the shoreline at low tide. Evenings settle into long, golden sunsets reflected on calm water as the vessel sits steady at anchor. It's a rare chance to work surrounded by the raw beauty of the West Coast.

### Position Overview

We are seeking a personable, self-sufficient, and highly capable Relief Innkeeper to step in during select periods throughout the summer. This is a **hands-on, guest-facing role** ideal for someone who thrives in a dynamic environment and enjoys long, full days of meaningful hospitality work.

Shifts are typically 2–4 consecutive days, averaging approximately one shift per week throughout the summer (depending on bookings). In slower periods, there may be **opportunities to assist with maintenance and boat projects at \$27/hour.**

This role requires stamina, efficiency, and presence of mind. You will be the primary host onboard, managing meals, guest experience, water taxi runs, and vessel tidiness, while maintaining a calm and welcoming atmosphere.

## Key Responsibilities

- Serve as the **main point of contact for guest groups** during your shift.
- **Coordinate check-in and check-out** and water taxi transfers
- **Operate the water taxi** (boating proficiency an asset; SVOP training provided if needed)
- **Prepare and serve daily meals** (morning coffee/tea, breakfast, dinner, dessert) for 8–12 guests
- Maintain **cleanliness and order** in cabins, common areas, and galley
- Ensure a warm and memorable guest experience
- Manage basic operational needs of the vessel during your shift

**Cooking is a significant component of this role.** You must be comfortable preparing thoughtful, well-executed meals for a group while working quickly and confidently in the galley kitchen. Recipes will be provided, but flexibility and improvisation will be needed.

- **Hospitality experience** or strong customer service background
  - **Confident cooking** for 10–12 people (training provided on systems and menus)
  - Comfortable working **long, active days** in a physically demanding environment
  - **Boating proficiency:** Is an asset but will provided training if needed
  - Adaptable, resourceful, and calm under pressure
  - Physically capable of lifting, cleaning, and performing active work aboard a boat.
  - Friendly, resourceful, and comfortable living and working in a remote, off-grid setting
  - Available for **multiple 2–4 day shifts** between late May and early October
