POSITION OVERVIEW

Janitor 2 works three days per week, Thursday through Sunday, following a strict cleaning timeline to minimize guest disruption. The role includes deep cleaning of all washroom facilities, laundry room upkeep, and outdoor portable units.

UNIFORM & PRESENTATION

No formal uniform policy. Staff must wear non-slip footwear and be appropriately dressed for cleaning duties and outdoor walking.

- Cleaning and wiping down laundry room and machines
- Servicing two outdoor double portable flushable washrooms
- Following a strict cleaning timeline to minimize guest inconvenience
- Comfortable working in gendered facilities

- Unblocking toilets when needed (training provided)
- Light guest interaction and support when appropriate
- Reporting issues and supply needs to management
