Kackaamin provides family treatment services for individuals of all ages with a focus on building a healthy family attachment, trauma healing, and addictions recovery. Our NE'I (acting like an Aunt/Uncle) provides direct client care, guidance and support.

NE'I Responsibilities:

- Collaborate to support clients to meet their treatment goals
- Provide a safe, calm, non-judgmental approach to care and advocacy
- Support clients by engaging with them in their cabins and at community functions, mentor / support life skills development, time management, evidenced-based substance use and mental health support
- Communicate observations and updates with the care team
- Support clients with wellness goals including but not limited to development of communication skills, emotional regulation, attachment with their children and goal setting
- Support conflict resolution, problem solving development, and other necessary coping skills
- Provide medication assistance, drive clients as required
- Facility upkeep and program support

Job Requirements:

- 3 years+ Sobriety/abstinence from alcohol, marijuana, and other illicit substances
- Community Mental Health Worker certification or Addictions Counselling diploma (or similar field)
- Experience and/or knowledge of working with Indigenous-led organizations and communities; Openness to learn about the Kackaamin practice philosophy and goals of care
- Trauma-informed practice certification, training, +/- or experience delivering culturally-appropriate care
- Vulnerable Sector Check and Criminal Record Check clearance
- Valid First Aid certification
- BC Driver's License (class 5) with clear driving abstract
