Kackaamin provides family treatment services for individuals of all ages with a focus on building healthy family attachment, trauma healing, and addictions recovery. Responsibilities include being part of a trauma informed team and delivering high quality care to clients that need safe housing and continued support in recovery from addictions and trauma. This position contributes directly to the clients' holistic recovery by addressing fundamental aspects of self-worth, self-care and life skills.

## **RSW** Key Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the team to support clients to meet their treatment goals
- Provide a calm, non-judgmental approach to care and advocacy
- Support clients in their housing units and in community, mentor life skills development, time management, evidenced-based substance protocols and mental health support
- Document and share observations and updates with the care team

- Support clients with wellness goals, communication skills, emotional regulation, attachment and goal setting
- Support conflict resolution, problem solving development, and other necessary coping skills
- Provide medication assistance, drive clients for urgent care and community opportunities
- Facility upkeep and program support as needed

## **Job Requirements:**

- 3 years+ sobriety/abstinence from alcohol, marijuana, and other illicit substances
- Community Mental Health Worker certification or Addictions Counselling diploma (or similar field)
- Experience and/or knowledge of working with Indigenous-led organizations and communities; Openness to learn about and integrate Kackaamin practice philosophy and goals of care
- Trauma-informed practice certification, training, +/or experience delivering culturallyappropriate care
- Vulnerable Sector Check and Criminal Record Check clearance
- Valid First Aid certification
- BC Driver's License (class 5) with clear driving abstract
