RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Park Manager, the Park Attendants are responsible for ensuring park visitors have a memorable park experience and that our parks are kept safe and clean! Duties include welcoming visitors, providing information to guests, cleaning campsites, cleaning washrooms and pit toilets, removing garbage and recycling, landscape cleanup and maintenance, and collecting fees.

PERSONAL QUALITIES AND EXPERIENCE:

- Ability and willingness to perform active/physical work for up to 8 hours and be able to lift 50 pounds.
- Practical experience in manual labour such as groundskeeping, gardening, farming or related work.
- Work both independently and as part of a team with professional communication skills.
- Passionate about outdoor recreation and parks systems.
- Self-motivated and proactive in the workplace.
- Ability to record pertinent information and write reports.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Seasonal employment starts in March and can last until late October. Our main busy season is from the May long weekend until the Labour Day weekend.
- Day shifts ability to work weekends and holidays.
- Full and part-time work is offered. Full- time work is 35-40 hours per week.
- Wages range from \$18 \$24 pr hour plus 4% vacation pay.
- Uniform is supplied.
