RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Park Manager, the Park Patrol is responsible for patrolling the park areas to ensure a safe, clean and compliant park environment for all guests. Duties include monitoring campgrounds and day use areas, ensuring compliance and security by following Park Regulations and responding appropriately, collecting fees, selling firewood and other maintenance/ cleaning duties as required.

PERSONAL QUALITIES AND EXPERIENCE:

- Enjoy outdoor work and patrolling campgrounds at night.
- Your communication and public relation skills are excellent and include conflict resolution.
- You are proactive and adept at policy enforcement in a friendly manner.
- Self-motivated and proactive in the workplace with great time management skills.
- Passionate about outdoor recreation and parks systems.
- Able to perform physical activity for an 8-hour shift.
- Ability to record pertinent information and to write reports.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Seasonal employment starts in March and can continue until late October. Our main busy season is from the May long weekend until Labour Day weekend.
- Evening shifts – ability to work weekends and holidays.
- Full and part - time work is offered. Full – time work is 35 to 40 hours per week.
- Wages range from \$18 to \$24 per hour plus 4% vacation pay.
- Uniform supplied.
