What You'll Do:

- Align and position pipes to prepare them for installation.
 - Check slopes for conformance to requirements, using levels or lasers.
 - Connect pipe pieces and seal joints.
 - Cover pipes with earth or other materials.
 - Cut pipes to required lengths.
 - Dig trenches to desired or required depths, by hand or using trenching tools.
 - Grade and level trench bases, using tamping machines and hand tools.
 - Install and repair sanitary and storm water sewer structures and pipe systems.
 - Lay out pipe routes, following written instructions or blueprints, and coordinating layouts with supervisors and municipal requirements.
 - Locate existing pipes needing repair or replacement, using magnetic or radio indicators.
 - Tap and drill holes into pipes to introduce auxiliary lines or devices.
 - Install and use instruments such as lasers, grade rods, and transit levels.
 - Direct operators of equipment to achieve correct grade by adjusting earth, gravel, and other materials.
 - Measure distances from reference points to locate construction boundaries.
 - Verify curvature of graded surfaces using a hand level.
 - Perform equipment checks and report mechanical problems to supervisors or mechanics.
 - Identify and mitigate hazards on site.
