Kackaamin Family Development Centre is looking for a Recovery Careworker to join our team. This position requires a kind, positive and helpful individual to assist our Supportive Recovery Program.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide transportation for clients to appointments, programming, and urgent care (valid BC Class 5 driver's license required)
 - Collaborate with female clients and the care team to support progress toward individualized treatment and wellness goals within a sober-living program environment
 - Provide calm, non-judgmental, trauma-informed support and advocacy
 - Support life-skills development (communication, emotional regulation, and time management)
 - Communicate client observations and updates with the care team
 - Provide medication assistance, program support, and light facility upkeep as needed

Qualifications & Requirements

- Minimum 3 years of sobriety/abstinence; willingness to sign an abstinence agreement
 - Community Mental Health Worker Certificate, Addictions Counselling Diploma, or related field preferred *Experience may also be considered*
 - Criminal Record Check (required)
 - Valid First Aid certification
 - Valid BC Class 5 Driver's License with a clear driver's abstract
