DURATION: Full-time and part-time seasonal positions (March – October)

DESCRIPTION: Our SVOP Skippers are responsible for operating tours in Clayoquot and/or Barkley Sound. Skippers run our 12-passenger vessels in a safe & secure manner, while delivering an exciting and educational tour to our guests who travel across the globe to see our local wildlife.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assure pre-departure checks have been completed, including checks of engine, safety equipment, weather and appropriate route planning. Properly fuel-up, record voyages in logbooks and store equipment after use.
- Communicate any maintenance issues with Maintenance Team and work with them to resolve issues
- Safely navigate vessel for duration of tours (2.5-3 hours) in accordance with your certification and the 'rules of the road'. Ensure that all marine, environmental and wildlife viewing guidelines are being met and or exceeded
- Provide outstanding interpretation for guests in relation to local ecosystems and wildlife, all whilst focussed on guest safety and comfort
- Contribute to photos, videos, and data to our research partners
- Take part in crew training sessions

- Knowledge and experience operating in coastal environments. Experience in Clayoquot and Barkley Sounds an asset.
- Some knowledge and experience maintaining marine equipment and engines.
