RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Park Manager, the Park Attendants are responsible for ensuring park visitors have a memorable park experience and that our parks are kept safe and clean! Must be comfortable working alone and as part of a team.

Duties include:

- Preparing daily paperwork for reservations from the online reservation system
- Welcoming visitors and providing information to guests
- Checking in reservations, collecting camping fees and selling firewood
- Cleaning campsites, washrooms, and pit toilets
- Removing garbage and recycling
- Landscape cleanup and maintenance.

Must be able to work on weekends and holidays.
