

Job Posting for Summer Program Assistant

The Alberni Valley Food Security Society (AVFSS) seeks an independent individual that is enthusiastic, comfortable working outdoors, and has a passion for food security initiatives. The primary purpose of this position is to assist with the coordination of seasonal programs for the AVFSS. Applicants for this position must be able to work with minimal supervision, comfortable interacting with community groups or the general public, and committed to the vision of a food secure Alberni Valley - when all people, at all times, have access to nutritious, safe, personally acceptable, and culturally appropriate foods, produced in ways that are environmentally sound and socially just. The candidate will have mentorship and indirect supervision by the manager of AVFSS as well as other long-standing members.

Three Primary Focus Areas

- 1. Coordinate the gleaning project (communicating with volunteer pickers and property owners, mapping out fruit trees, administering sign up and fee payment, organizing pick days and times and providing physical leadership at gleaning events).
- 2. Aid our community garden manager in the administration of rental and educational beds, coordination of work parties and assisting with general maintenance tasks.
- 3. Participation in AVFSS and community events with development of materials/ideas for food programming.

Preferred Qualifications

- Keen interest in food security initiatives and agriculture.
- Demonstrated ability to work independently.
- Ability to collaborate and network with community stakeholders.
- Comfortable with public interaction and personning tables at community events.
- Familiar with social media platforms, Google Docs, word processing.
- Have a valid driver's license or alternative transportation options.

Remuneration

\$20 per hour (inclusive of GST) based on experience and qualifications.

To note: this position is funded/sponsored by the Canada Summer Jobs program. All applicants must meet age and availability requirements of the program; under 30 years old and availability to work 33.75 hours per week for the eight-week timeframe.
