Responsibilities:

- Monitor switches, valves, pressure gauges, alarms, measure temperatures, detect leaks and/or other equipment failures, troubleshoot in time to ensure the plant equipment is operating at the highest efficiency
- Start and stop the control switch operation of each device, troubleshoot and implement corrective actions and minor repairs to prevent equipment and system failure
- Lubricate the moving parts of the equipment with appropriate lubricants daily/weekly, Clean the equipment after maintenance, including ground/area
- Fill in daily logs in accordance with Technical safety BC

Requirements:

- Completion and possession of a 4TH Class Power Engineering certification or equivalent that permits the holder to operate a refrigeration or Freezing plant
- Has mechanical maintenance knowledge and skills
- Familiar with applicable legislated regulations
- Safety awareness and performance of duties corresponding to legislated requirements
- Work in temperature controlled refrigerated/chilled workspace
- Able to perform physical duties which may include lifting, kneeling, climbing crawling and twisting
