Employment Counselling: WorkBC can help you achieve your job search, career development and training goals with the personalized, one-on-one support of an Employment Counsellor. If you are unemployed or working fewer than 20 hours per week, not currently in school, and legally entitled to work in Canada, you may be eligible for financial supports for skills training, short term courses, jobsearch workshops, career assessments and job start supports.



Getting Started: The first step is to make an appointment with one a WorkBC Employment Counsellor to confirm your eligibility.
