➢ Job start supports: WorkBC can provide financial supports to eligible clients beginning a new job when they do not have the financial means to cover incremental costs before receiving a paycheque from a new job. Financial supports range in amount and can help cover expenses for essential work clothing and equipment, transportation, dependent care, licensing and hygiene supports. Clients should request financial supports prior to starting a new job and will undergo a financial needs assessment with a WorkBC Employment Counsellor.

### Short Term Orientation and Certificate

**(STOC):** Short Term Orientation and Certificates provide certification for basic workplace safety and orientation to meet regulatory requirements and / or provide certification to meet industry standards for entry-level employment. STOC topics include Food Safe, Serving it Right, Emergency and Standard First Aid, WHIMIS, traffic control and many other training courses that are up to 35 hours in total duration.
