# **Spotlight on Services**

### Trades Training

Ever considered a career in the trades? The need for skilled tradespeople in B.C. is increasing, along with exciting, wellpaid, employment opportunities. To work as a certified tradesperson, you need training combined with job experience. Trades training typically takes between one to five years. Most apprenticeship programs take four years. The technical training takes place in a classroom or shop setting at a public institution such as a college or institute, or at an approved private training institution. To earn your "ticket" as a certified tradesperson in B.C., you must:

- Complete the required on-the-job hours and the inschool training
- Pass the examinations
- > Earn the recommendation of your sponsoring employer.

## Customized Employment: Customized

Employment is a flexible process designed to personalize the employment relationship between a job seeker and an employer in a way that meets the needs of both. Customized Employment involves providing individualized services to job seekers and employers when individuals have complex employment support needs and require support services to obtain and maintain employment. An employment counsellor will work with a job seeker to assess their strengths, needs



and interests to identify best-match scenarios between work environments, supports, client interests and work tasks. Customized Employment also involves the creation of unique employment opportunities, based on these best-match scenarios, by identifying, initiating or creating new jobs, carving existing jobs through negotiating to re-arrange work tasks or creating self-employment opportunities specifically customized to the job seeker's needs, skills, abilities and competencies.
