Employment Counselling: WorkBC can help you achieve your job search, career development and training goals with the personalized, one-on-one support of an Employment Counsellor. If you are unemployed or working fewer than 20 hours per week, not currently in school, and legally entitled to work in Canada, you may be eligible for financial supports for skills training, short term courses, jobsearch workshops, career assessments and job start supports.



Getting Started: The first step is to make an

appointment with one of the WorkBC Employment Counsellors to confirm your eligibility.

> Job start supports: WorkBC can provide financial supports to eligible clients beginning a new job when they do not have the financial means to cover incremental costs before receiving a paycheque from a new job. Financial supports range in amount and can help cover expenses for essential work clothing and equipment, transportation, dependent care, licensing and hygiene supports. Clients should request financial supports prior to starting a new job and will undergo a financial needs assessment with a WorkBC Employment Counsellor.
