Spotlight on Services

➤ **Wage Subsidy:** WorkBC's Wage Subsidy service is designed to assist job seekers to gain work experience and learn new skills, by providing a financial incentive for employers to provide on-the-job training. Wage subsidy participants must be unemployed or underemployed (working less than 20 hours a week). Recent changes to the WorkBC wage subsidy service were made to allow more individuals to access the service. Employees who were previously laid off from a position are now able to be recalled by their employer using a wage subsidy. The Wage Subsidy service can be accessed through two separate avenues: A WorkBC Match Wage Subsidy occurs when a WorkBC case managed client is identified by the contractor as an appropriate candidate to refer to a potential wage subsidy position; or an Employer Identified Wage Subsidy occurs when an eligible employer identifies an individual as suitable for a potential Wage Subsidy position.



Getting Started: Visit workbc.ca to find the online employer application. If you are a job seeker, you can talk to a potential employer about wage subsidy and suggest they apply or apply for WorkBC Employment Services and explore if a wage subsidy opportunity is a good fit for you.

➤ **Skills Enhancement Training Services:**

Skills Enhancement Training Services assist eligible clients to obtain the skills necessary to obtain employment through participation in training that may range from Adult Basic Education and Academic Upgrading to Occupational Skills Training and Short Duration Training. Training may be delivered by either a public training institute or an accredited private training institute. Eligible case-managed clients can also receive financial supports to assist their training needs.

INEO's Outstanding Women Learners and Leaders (OWLL) is a program that offers life, employability and skills training for careers in health care, hospitality, trades and entrepreneurship. This employment program is for women who have experienced violence and/or abuse and live in or near the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District.

Eligibility requirements:

- Women (17+) who are legally entitled to work in Canada
- Unemployed or precariously employed
- Self identifies as someone who experienced violence and/or abuse
- Requiring skills needed for successful integration or re-integration into employment
- Living in or near the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District
- Individuals on EI (income deductions apply), PWD or IA (income deductions apply). Remember that [sources of income](#) as well as any training you may undertake should be reported.
