Spotlight on Services

➤ **Employment Counselling:** WorkBC can help you achieve your job search, career development and training goals with the personalized, one-on-one support of an Employment Counsellor. If you are unemployed or working fewer than 20 hours per week, not currently in school, and legally entitled to work in Canada, you may be eligible for financial supports for skills training, short term courses, job-search workshops, career assessments and job start supports.



Getting Started: The first step is to make an appointment with one of our Employment Counsellors to confirm your eligibility.

➤ **Training Financial Supports:** All case-managed WorkBC clients may be eligible for financial supports for costs associated with Skills Enhancement Training Services, including tuition, books and supplies, the cost of travelling to and from a course, incidental training expenses and living away from home.

➤ AMPED

Are you 50 + and looking for employment or a career change? INEO Employment Services is offering the Assisting Mature Persons in Employment Development (AMPED) program to assist unemployed or precariously employed older workers to build skills and increase employability. AMPED is a hybrid (group-based and semi-independent) program with two streams available. A 10-week cohort-based program offered twice per

year for six participants and semi-independent program with an Employment Coach/Job Developer for up to 24 participants in the first year.

Eligibility requirements include:

- Individuals between the ages of 50 - 64+ (exceptions will be considered for younger applicants)
- Requiring skills needed for successful integration or re-integration into employment
- Living in or near the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District
- Individuals who are legally entitled to work in Canada



Applications for AMPED may be submitted in-person to INEO Employment Services at 4908 Argyle Street or via Email: info@ineoemployment.com. INEO will screen applicants through an interview process and select participants based on eligibility, need and fit for each stream. The next cohorts will begin in January 2021 and April 2021.
