Trades Training: Ever considered a career in the trades? The need for skilled tradespeople in B.C. is increasing, along with exciting, well-paid, employment opportunities. To work as a certified tradesperson, you need training combined with job experience. Trades training typically takes between one to five years. Most apprenticeship programs take four years. The technical training takes place in a classroom or shop setting at a public institution such as a college or institute or at an approved private training institution. To earn your "ticket" as a certified tradesperson in B.C., you must:



- Complete the required on-the-job hours and the in-school training
- Pass the examinations
- Earn the recommendation of your sponsoring employer.
